

# GP Minor Surgery

List of treatments available for GP minor surgery

Treatment Type	Reason
Injections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intra-articular</li> <li>• Peri-articular</li> <li>• Haemorrhoids</li> </ul>
Aspirations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Joints</li> <li>• Cysts</li> <li>• Bursae</li> <li>• Hydroceles</li> </ul>
Excisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Epidermal cysts</li> <li>• Skin lesions for histology</li> <li>• Intradermal naevi, dermatofibroma, etc</li> <li>• Removal of toe nails</li> </ul>
Incisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Abscesses</li> <li>• Cysts</li> <li>• Thrombosed piles</li> </ul>
Curette, cautery & cryocautery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Other skin lesions (treatment for warts, verrucas and skin tags is excluded)</li> </ul>
Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Removal of foreign bodies</li> <li>• Nasal cautery</li> <li>• Ear syringing/irrigation/microsuction (first only)</li> <li>• Tongue tie release</li> <li>• Sutures</li> </ul>
